Mode of Mop-up Counselling:

Mop-up Counselling will be done physically i.e. in person. Mop-up counselling for Govt. Quota seats and Management Quota seats will be done on **08.05.2019 (Wednesday)**.

Reservation:

Mop-up Counselling will be done in sessions. In the first session Reservation will be allowed for Govt. Quota seats. Thereafter unfilled seats will be converted into unreserved seats and offered as per Merit. Mop-up counselling will be done separately for Government quota and Management quota seats.

Mop-up Counselling Schedule:

	09.30 am	Govt. Quota Seats	All UT of Puducherry candidates can participate. Even the candidates who have joined are allowed as the seats surrendered from AIQ were not offered during 2 nd round.
	10.00 am	Management Quota Seats	All India basis (all Candidates)

Eligibility:

Students who have joined colleges after 2nd round counselling are **NOT eligible** for Mop-up Counselling except for Govt. Quota seats in view of the surrender of AIQ seats. Students who have not joined are eligible for Mop-up counselling but the registration fee paid during 2nd round will be forfeited. (Please refer PG-Medical Education Regulations as amended from time to time).

Seat Matrix: Updated seat matrix is published and Students are advised to go through the seat matrix.



Details of Filled and Vacant seats:

The updated list of candidates who have joined after 2nd round of counselling for PG-Medical seats is published. The names of the candidates who have paid fees but have opted out subsequently have been removed. The details of filled seats and vacant seats are updated in the website.

Note: Candidates are advised to verify the list of joined candidates. If the name of a candidate who has been allotted seat in 2nd round, paid fee is not found in the list, the candidate is advised to send details before 11 am on 05.05.2019 to centacpg19@pec.edu.

Sliding is allowed only for the Govt. Quota seats as 2 seats have been surrendered from All India Quota (AIQ) in the Govt. Medical College. Other than the above exception, NO SLIDING will be permitted in the Mop-up Counseling.

Fees: During Mop-up counseling, seats will be allotted **only after the entire tuition fee is paid**, preferably by way of DD (Demand Draft) or through RTGS/NEFT, otherwise seat will not be allotted. For this purpose candidates can either transfer the fee in advance to CENTAC account mentioned in website or bring DD for fee amount in favour of CENTAC.

In case of NEFT/RTGS transfer amount credited will be refunded if seat is not allotted. For the fee amount, students are advised to see the fee order on website.

Forfeiture of fees in case of Non-joining:

If the student fails to join the allotted college after Mop-up counseling, then an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- will be forfeited. In case, the College is not able to fill the seat from the 1:10 list sponsored by CENTAC, then entire tuition fee will be forfeited. Where the college is able to fill the seat, the fee paid after deducting Rs.2,00,000/- will be refunded after 6 months time.

Admission: Colleges have been asked to set up Admission help desks in CENTAC so that students can complete admission on the spot soon after allotment of seats. Students are accordingly advised to bring all the certificates.

Instructions to Candidates:

Candidates will be called in the order of Merit. Please see the seat matrix, evaluate your choices and accordingly decide for participation in counselling.

Documents to be produced at the time of counselling:

1. Result/Rank letter issued by NBE
2. Documents for reservation claimed
3. Proof of fee paid (RTGS/NEFT reference or DD)
