Horticulture : Admission is based on the marks secured by the candidates in the prescribed subjects in the qualifying examination (i.e. Biology / (Botany & Zoology), Physics, Chemistry and any one of the optional subjects like Bio-Chemistry or Bio-Technology or Microbiology or Home Science or Computer Science & Mathematics including practicals) and normalizing them by the prescribed procedure.</p>	<p>For drawing the merit of the candidate, the marks scored in three subjects viz., Physics, Chemistry and Biology (or mean of Botany and Zoology) shall be considered. If a candidate had studied four subjects in 10+2 or Intermediate viz., Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Agriculture / Forestry the marks scored in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be considered for drawing merit list.</p> <p>Mark in each of three subjects would be added and the aggregate of the three subjects would be taken for ranking for a maximum of 200 marks.</p> <p>In the case of qualifying examination other than Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary (H.Sc.) Examination, normalization procedure as prescribed by CENTAC, Govt. of Puducherry will be followed. Ranking of the candidates will be done based on the 'normalised marks' (rounded-off to three decimal places) arrived at, to a base of 200.</p>
